A big well done goes out to Josh, Terence, Isla and Sophia who came away with a Bronze Medal.






#### **NDCC Art Alumni Success**

## **New Parent Resource to support RSE:** Ten:Ten

Our Relationships and Sex Education reflects our mission to 'opening hearts, minds and doors'.

As a Catholic school, our mission is to support the spiritual, moral, social and cultural development of all of our pupils, rooted in the wisdom and teaching of the Church. The education of children in human sexuality is an important responsibility. The Church teaches us that this is very much a partnership with parents, in which parents are the 'first educators' of their children on these matters; and we in school are here to support you.

We will be using a new programme to support the delivery of our RSE programme called Ten Ten. The programme has been approved by our diocese and is in partnership with the Catholic Education Service and the Department for Education to provide training for teachers in Catholic schools on Relationships and Sex Education.







Ten Ten have provided an Online Parent Portal which will be a tool we can use throughout the year to keep you informed and updated about the work we are doing in school. We will be asking for your feedback on the programme and resources in the spring term once all pupils have completed the first part of their relationships and sex education programme. **Further details will be sent via ParentApp next week.**


